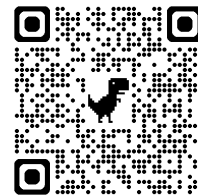

This event sells out quickly and features raffle baskets donated by businesses and PR teams/clubs/activities, along with a silent auction and more. While teams, clubs and activities receive direct funds when parents volunteer, concessions remain a key fundraiser for the Booster Club.

How do teams and groups receive Booster Club funding?
